- Able to navigate complex and sensitive conversations with professionalism, maintaining constructive dialogue even when perspectives differ.
- Can provide constructive feedback and ideas
- Value collaboration, inclusion, and systems improvement

People from diverse backgrounds and communities are strongly encouraged to apply.

Support and Participation

WAAEH is committed to safe, inclusive, and trauma-informed engagement. While there is an aspect of contributing storytelling within these opportunities, there is no expectation for people to share any detailed experiences. The role is to provide a lived experience lens to the work of WAAEH and to guide the conversations to ensure a holistic approach is considered.

Support provided may include:

- Clear session preparation and facilitation
- Remuneration for participation
- Flexible participation options
- Respectful handling of lived experience contributions

- Sessions are held periodically and facilitated by WAAEH
